Greeting Fellow Knights!

We are starting to get going on our many activities and I am welcome all Knights to participate as much as you can.

One of the important things that are coming up in October are the Tootsie Roll drive to help those with intellectual disabilities. On the weekend of the 13<sup>th</sup> please participate if you are able to. We will have Knights in front of local area stores giving tootsie rolls for donations. It is a fun and rewarding experience but it does take a lot of volunteers, so if you are available to help and have not yet been contacted please let me know.

Dome concessions have started for the year as well. We have games we will work on Oct 5<sup>th</sup> and on Oct 27<sup>th</sup>, so let Kenny Kramer or Ken Keller know if you are able to help.

At the beginning of the month on October 1<sup>st</sup> the Knights' Rosary will start again. This tradition of having a monthly Rosary at 6:30 the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of the month has been very successful in past years and I expect that tradition to continue. October is the month of the Rosary so it is the perfect time to start.

The Rosary is a very powerful prayer and in addition to the normal benefits of meditating on the Gospel and praying the prayers, there is a plenary indulgence granted, if the Rosary is recited in a church or public oratory.

In addition to those things, Our Lady revealed to St. Dominic and Blessed Alan de la Roche additional benefits for those who devoutly pray the Rosary:

The Fifteen Promises of Mary to Christians Who Recite the Rosary:

1. Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the rosary, shall receive signal graces.
2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the rosary.
3. The rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell, it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies.
4. It will cause virtue and good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire of eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.
5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the rosary, shall not perish.
6. Whoever shall recite the rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its sacred mysteries shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His justice, he shall not perish by an unprovided death; if he be just he shall remain in the grace of God, and become worthy of eternal life
7. Whoever shall have a true devotion for the rosary shall not die without the sacraments of the Church.
8. Those who are faithful to recite the rosary shall have during their life and at their death the light of God and the plenitude of His graces; at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of the saints in paradise.

9. I shall deliver from purgatory those who have been devoted to the rosary.
10. The faithful children of the rosary shall merit a high degree of glory in heaven.
11. You shall obtain all you ask of me by the recitation of the rosary (as long as it is not against the Will of God and is good for your salvation).
12. All those who propagate the holy rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.
13. I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the rosary shall have for intercessors the entire celestial court during their life and at the hour of death.
14. All who recite the rosary are my sons, and brothers of my only son Jesus Christ.
15. Devotion of my rosary is a great sign of predestination.

These promises, given in divine private revelation, are a good incentive to take a look at praying the Rosary if you have not already. Please participate in the group Rosary on the 1<sup>st</sup> and every first Monday of the month from October to June.

Another activity we are promoting in October is the selling of Football Frenzy coupons. For a \$10 donation, people participating have the opportunity to win many prizes and it helps our chapter for each ticket sold. Every week of the contest \$750 in prizes will be given away.
